

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



CAUTION! Make sure electricity is off before and during installation or maintenance. The luminaire must be installed by a qualified professional in accordance with all applicable local regulations.

All LEDs are already built into your lamp. Avoid contacting the LED surface with bare hands, as this could shorten its lifespan. Avoid modifying, relocating, or removing any electrical parts. Ensure that the electrical system where the fixture will be installed operates at 120 volts.

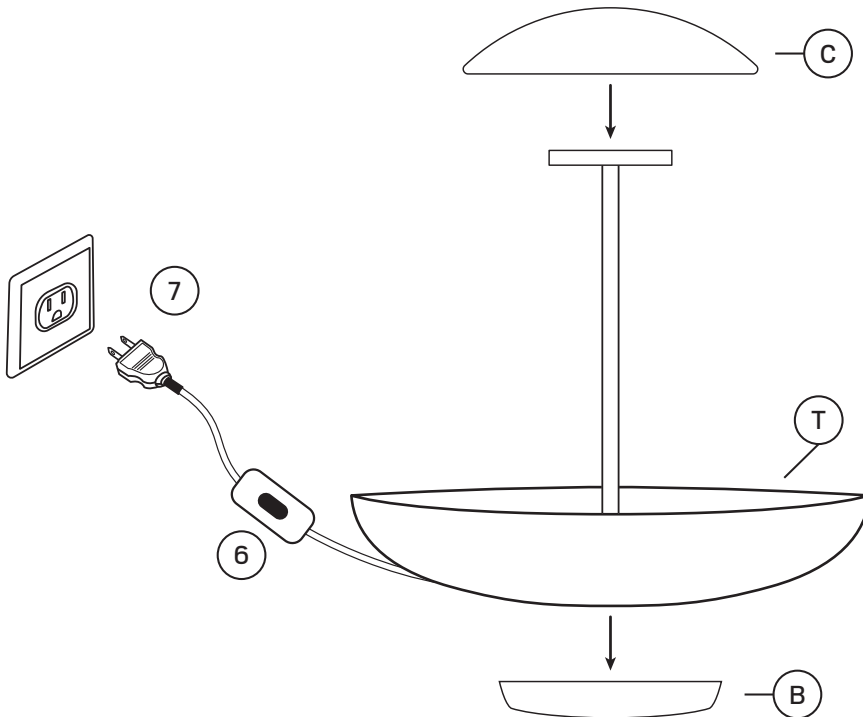

Description: Garden table lamp

Composition: ceramic and aluminum

Instructions:

- 1) Verify that the lamp's voltage matches the voltage of the power outlet you plan to use.
- 2) Carefully remove the protective packaging from the product, ensuring that no sharp objects or edges damage any part in the process. Lay all components of the lamp on a flat surface, and if needed, use the packaging material as a cushion to protect the parts from scratches or other damage.
- 3) Place the terrarium (T) at the center of the base (B).
- 4) Fill the terrarium (T) with soil and plants of your choice to achieve your desired arrangement.
- 5) Fix the dome (C) securely in place, aligning it at the top center.
- 6) Use the switch located on the power cord to turn the lamp on or off as desired.
- 7) Insert the plug into a compatible outlet, ensuring it matches the lamp's voltage, and now your lamp is ready for use!



ATTENTION! Failure to comply with the instructions in this manual may cause accidents and void the product warranty. It is recommended that you read these instructions completely and carefully before proceeding. Make sure that the rated voltage requirements of the luminaire are compatible with the electric supply.
